We always strive to be a family club and as such encourage everyone to participate in the club's activities, be they cricketing or otherwise. Again this year we will be offering one free (non-voting) social membership for a parent or guardian with each junior membership, we would be very grateful however to any additional parents/guardians/relatives who wish to take up a social membership at just £15 for the year. We have attached a social membership form to the back of this junior form and please feel free to request additional forms if required.

Those of you who were members in 2019 will have hopefully joined us on our Friday Junior Training Night's up at the club. We have seen some really good evenings with BBQ's and the like and we plan on building on the Friday Night experience this season, further details to follow.

New for 2020

Membership Card Scheme. We have noted that many other clubs operate a two tier pricing system behind their bars to enable prices for members to be kept as low as possible. We will be introducing such a scheme at Findon this year whereby members' prices will apply to those members showing their individually named and numbered membership card when buying at the bar.

As mentioned above social membership is just £15 for the season so we would encourage additional memberships to be purchased - £60 would cover a junior membership plus both parents/carers for example.

Signing-on Night. On Friday 17th April we will be holding our first ever signing-on night. This evening will be an opportunity for members to gather before the season commences, collect membership cards and for any outstanding membership fees and forms to be collected. We hope you can join us on the 17th – times to be confirmed nearer the date. The bar will be open!
